What is an Early College High School?

The purpose of an Early College High School is to enable students to receive a high school diploma and an Associate's Degree by taking a mixture of high school and Austin Community College classes throughout their 4 years at Lanier High School. Students are provided with academic and social support services that allow them to achieve 60 college credit hours by the time they graduate high school; increasing college readiness and decreasing barriers to a post-secondary education. All of this at no added cost to them.

What is a Summer Bridge Program?

Once a student completes an application and is admitted into the Early College High School at Lanier, our Summer Bridge Program will provide preparation and support for students by instilling a collegiate mindset and allowing them to develop the skills necessary to succeed in their college classes. The program will run from Monday-Thursday / 9am-12pm / June 4-14. Sessions will include:
